June 11 2022	\$10 pastel workshop	Create a painting using soft pastels. Learn how to blend colours and enjoy the brilliance of this extremely portable medium.
June 18 2022	\$10 pouring workshop	A fun and easy way to create beautiful and unique abstract art by pouring acrylic paint on canvas.
June 25 2022	\$10 watercolour workshop	Learn about watercolour paint and paper and some simple techniques to help you get started with this wonderful medium.
July 2 2022	\$10 print making workshop	Carve your own printing block or stamp using Ezy Carve. Then hand print your wonderful design using colourful inks.
July 9 2022	\$10 acrylic Inks workshop	Acrylic inks are a fun and versatile way to create a painting. These inks are brightly coloured, highly expressive, and extremely fluid.
July 16 2022	\$10 pottery cow workshop	In this workshop you will hand build a cow planter to hold your favourite indoor plant. Firing is not included but for \$5.00 you can have your work bisque fired at the Art Centre.

August 6 2022	\$10 acrylic workshop	Acrylic paint is versatile and can be used in many different ways. For this workshop the paints will be used on canvas.
August 13 2022	\$10 pottery chick w/shop	In this workshop you will hand build a decorative chicken. Firing is not included but for \$5.00 you can have your work bisque fired at the Art Centre.
